

SWAMP CYPRESS

Environment from Florida Everglades, plenty water.

Beware of branch cutting as the branches bleed when sprouting. Wait until mid winter when there is no root activity and the pruning.

Repot in mid winter - June July for the southern hemisphere.

It can take a lot of cold and is also tolerant of light frost.

Its roots can stay permanently submerged in water, but be careful if it is in water for too long as roots get very soft.

When wiring the growth will slow dramatically.

To bend branches down wards take a sharp chisel and break the branch. It heals very easily.
